Online Permission Forms

In an effort to reduce time, money and paper waste, parents will be able to submit all permission forms through a secure online website. Thorsby Jr/Sr High School is excited to announce that starting September 2017, all permission forms will be online through our fee payment portal, Acorn Online Payments through PowerSchool Parent Portal. If you do not have a parent account set up we have contacted you recently by mail with more information on how to do this. If you do not have internet access, we will have a kiosk at the school for your use in the office as well as help with this process. A mobile App is also available for your smart phone.

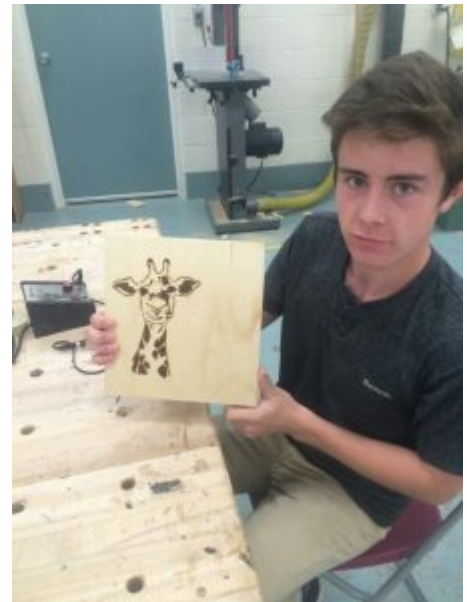
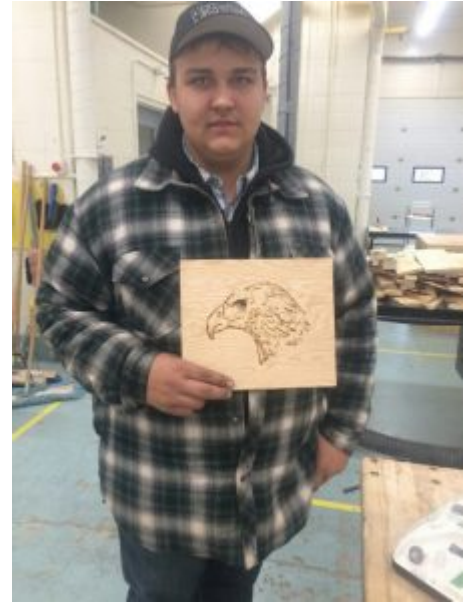

There are some amazing projects coming out of our shop this year. Take a look at a few of the finished projects.



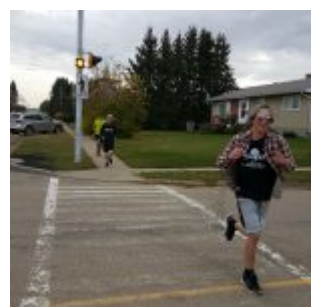
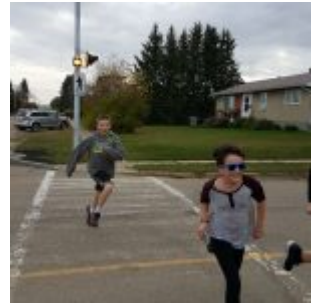




Terry Fox Run







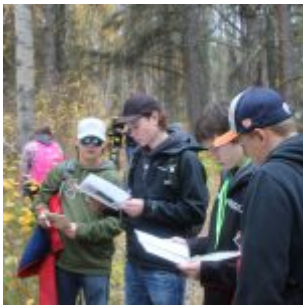
