What supplies should I buy my child for September?

- 2 good quality, large 2.5", 3-ring binder (zippered)
- Blue or black pens
- 50 sheets unlined paper
- HB pencils and erasers
- 1000 sheets lined loose leaf
- Pencil crayons/markers
- 1 red pen
- 4 duo tangs
- Dividers (package)
- Glue sticks
- Geometry set
- Highlighter pens
- scientific calculator (basic for junior high)
- Calculator (Tl83 or equivalent for high school)
- Pencil case
- Coiled scribblers (2)
- Change of clothes for gym (non-marking runners, shorts/sweats)
- Tape
- Reinforcements
- Scissors
- Only school locks may be used on lockers

General Thoughts for Core Subjects

Two 2.5" binders, complete with lined paper and dividers are preferred for core subjects (Math, LA, Social Studies, Science) as there are handouts that students will need to file/store and assignments that will need to be handed in. Scribblers will not meet these needs. Duo-tangs will not handle the volume of paper over the course of the school year.

A pencil case/soft sided tool box that is transferable to each binder containing pencils/pens (blue or black), pencil crayons, glue stick, etc is recommended.
