Here we are, at the beginning of a new school year. To our new families, welcome to Thorsby Junior Senior High School. To our old families, welcome back.

I know that the beginning of the school year brings many increased emotions especially this year. Excitement, trepidation, and anxiety are all common emotions to have when returning to school. Having not been in-person for ~6 months will only heighten all of these as well as likely elicit others that aren't listed. These are all normal and as we continue through the school year the more negative feelings will wane, while hopefully the positive emotions will continue to grow.

We will start the school year with slightly less staffing than previous years as we had to transfer staff to the Black Gold Distance School to account for the students from TJSHS. We will start with 10.3 Teaching staff, 3 Educational Assistants, 1.5 Secretarial staff, and 0.5 Librarian. It should be noted that we had to transfer 0.7 teaching staff to the Distance Ed school. Many of you have likely heard that educational funding has increased this year and might be questioning why then are we down in teaching staff compared to last year. The reason for that is that the increase in funding was in operations and maintenance, not instruction. So yes, over the summer our gym got painted and parts in our HVAC, boiler, and security system were upgraded, but the overall instructional piece in budget was reduced. Unlike a household budget, one pot of money can't be used to cover a shortfall in another area. We can't just eat rice for a month to pay for fixing our car. The silver lining in all of this is that it is the first time in the six years that I have been

a principal that we aren't introducing a new staff member this year as all staff are returning members of TJSHS.

I believe that the staff of TJSHS is the most dedicated staff of any school in Black Gold. We welcome the challenges that the 2020/2021 school year will possess and we will also be there to celebrate the successes at the same time. I hope we all have a safe, healthy, and productive 20/21 school year. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me at the school or by email.

projects. My hobbies include woodworking, hunting, fishing, and numerous other outdoor activities.




Mrs. Kathy Verhun

Mrs. Kim van Steenis




