We made it through the first semester of 2020-2021. The second semester has started with a little bit of a chill. This likely means that especially for our high school students the rest of the semester will likely need to speed through a little bit of their curriculum as we have lost around 5 days from most classes. We did see that we had the following average attendance through the week: Grade 7 - 75%, Grade 8 - 42%, Grade 9 - 33%, Grade 10 - 32%, Grade 11 - 34%, Grade 12 - 32%.

So the school in general we had about 36% of our school population on any given day. Teachers followed our policy that no new curriculum is taught in classes that have less than 50% attendance, so students shouldn't feel worried about falling behind. But, that will likely mean that the rest of the year will be a little more packed.



We could have switched to online learning during that time, however, with the inability to provide technology to students that were absent it would have led to inequity and punished students who: Did not have a way to get to school and don't have access to technology at home. When we entered into Remote Learning at the beginning of December the school provided a chromebook to roughly 20% of our population or close to 40 students. So we take a mini review break at the beginning of the second semester, hope the temperature doesn't drop that low again this semester and put our noses to the grindstone next Tuesday when everyone is supposed to get much better.

I hope that everyone enjoys their Family Day. Here is a photo of Jack, Ruby and Lewis in warmer weather sledding. Lew has it worked out as Jack is carrying him back up the hill while Ruby pulls the sled.
