APPEAL PROCEDURES FOR MARKS, CREDITS, REPORT CARDS

In accordance with [Black Gold Administrative Procedure 390](#), appeals for school-awarded marks can be made for up to 10 business (school) days after the mark was issued on June 30th, 2022. Appeals can be made until noon, July 15, 2022 by contacting Mr. Theo Dykstra via email at: theo.dykstra@blackgold.ca.

Diploma Exam mark appeals are made via direct contact with Alberta Education on and after July 15, 2022 when marks are made available on myPass. Appeals for diploma exam marks must be made prior to August 8, 2022.

Credit checks for all grade 10 and 11 students will be completed over the summer and will be mailed out to parents by the end of September.

On July 15, 2022, diploma exam marks from June administration will be available on *myPass* on the Alberta Education website.
