APPEAL PROCEDURES FOR MARKS, CREDITS, REPORT CARDS

In accordance with <u>Black Gold Administrative Procedure 390</u>, appeals for school-awarded marks can be made for up to 10 business (school) days after the mark was issued on June 28th, 2024. Appeals can be made until noon, July 15, 2024 by contacting Mr. Daniel Hodges via email at: <u>daniel.hodges@blackgold.ca</u>.

Diploma Exam mark appeals are made via direct contact with Alberta Education on and after July 19, 2024 when marks are made available on <u>myPass</u>. Appeals for diploma exam marks must be made prior to August 6, 2024.

On July 19, 2024, diploma exam marks from June administration will be available on *myPass* on the Alberta Education website.
